

INCA TRAIL EXPRESS TO MACHU PICCHU (2 Days / 1 Night)



The well-preserved final stretch of the Inca Trail starting at Chachabamba (km 104) on the railroad, takes you up to Wiñaywayna and a stunning descent to Machu Picchu, first day hiking into the citadel through Inti Punku, the Sun gate. Second day early guided visit of Machu Picchu and train back to Cusco after lunch (not include). Overnight in Aguas Calientes or Machu Picchu town.

Itinerary description

DAY 1: CUSCO / KM 104 / WIÑAY WAYNA / MACHU PICCHU:

You will be transferred from Cusco to Poroy train station. Your train will go to 104 km. At this point after checking our entrances and passports with Machu Picchu Park rangers, We will start trekking for approximately 3 hours, up to the well-preserved remains of Wiñay Wayna (2900 m.a.s.l). On the way, we will see beautiful waterfalls, native flora and mountain birds. After lunch, we will have time to rest and enjoy exploring the site with its houses, terraces, towers, as well as visiting the Inti Punku, the Inca Gate of the Sun, where we will get our first sight of Machu Picchu. We finally cross the ridge that leads to our destination, and the full sight of the greatest archaeological discovery of modern times is revealed. After an overview and orientation about the city of Machu Picchu, you will take the shuttle bus that will take you down to Aguas Calientes, where we will spend the night.

A boxed lunch will be provided while trekking.

** Overnight at 3 Stars hotel.

Day 2: MACHUPICCHU / CUSCO:

After an early breakfast, passengers will be met by their guide at the hotel's lobby, then will take the bus up to Machupicchu and we will start the guided tour of the citadel. After this awesome visit, passengers will return to Aguas Calientes town. After lunch (not included) passengers will take the Expedition train back to Cusco. Upon arrival to Poroy train station, transfer in a private vehicle back to their hotel in Cusco.

- Train service provided is Expedition, in case clients prefer to take the Vistadome service, you will only be able to upgrade the train ticket to comeback and the extra charge is \$25.00 per person and the transfer to the hotel won't be included. The transfer will cost US\$ 25.00 per person.
- Minimum 2 people to make a reservation for Inca Trail Service (Check Availability) If clients wish to stay an extra night the Hotel will be for clients own. We can help with your hotels reservation and any other service requested. Entrance tickets to Huaynapicchu is not included, if passengers want to climb this mountain there is an extra cost for the tickets (\$ 72.00), it doesn't include the guided service.
- In case clients stay an extra night by their own, Apumayo will provide just train tickets for the next day, transfer and transportation won't be included. It can be request in case you need it.
